

Arpeggios for Bass

- Arpeggios are the notes of chords played one at a time
- Practice playing them ascending and descending
- Try to keep to 'one finger per fret' (for example, the C on the 3rd fret of the A string would be played with your second finger)
- Memorise the shape in C, then practice in all positions
